operation to be 1/2 per acre compared to Deere. Deere excells as far as operator comfort but we didn't like the fact that service can only be done at authorized dealers. Allis Chalmers has yet to design a rideable seat. Also, the control levers are convenient but elongated to the point of hitting each other in certain positions such as when in reverse and operating the 3pt. Performance is excellent when pulling a ridge-till cultivator, or other loads, compared to other brands we've compared it to. One problem is that the clutch cable is routed in such a way that it binds. After replacing three cables in 800 hrs., I routed the cable outside the hood to lessen the bend. If the cable were shorter, the problem would be eliminated.

"Heavy-built, lots of torque, quiet cab, easy to service, and has a short turning radius. We've been very satisfied with it," says Dan Bibler, Alta, Iowa about his 1979 White 2-135.

with our 1982 Case 2290 which the dealer took care of. Would like to see them eliminate the 'jerk' in the transmission when downshifting," says Emil Gabelmann, Lincoln, Kan.

"Our 1979 Long tractor has lots of power and is economical. All it needs is a better operator manual and parts book," George Smith, Richville, Minn.

"I've spent a fortune keeping this tractor going." says Elmer Quandt, Salem, Ill., about his 1975 Ford 8600. "I've had poor service. The dealer practically ruined this tractor."

"We're very satisfied with the good power and quiet cab on our 1982 International 5088. It's also easy on fuel. Problems are that the hydraulic levers are very hard to move and the hydraulic filters are very inconvenient and messy to change. Could also use a rear windshield wiper."

Lowell Bye, Corsica, S. Dak., owns a 1981 International 1086. "It's got excellent power and fuel economy. Have not had any problems. The hitch is hard to see but otherwise visibility is good. The tractor had a real slippage problem until we replaced the rear tires with radials. The radials were advertised to improve traction by 10% but I believe they do better than that."

"This **Deutz** DX160 is very fuel efficient and maintenance-free. We're pleased with it although it could use a hydraulic seat. I'll buy

another Deutz," says Ron Dieken, Cottonwood, Minn.

"It's been a lemon," says Kurt Dohse, DeWitt, Iowa, about his 4-WD Case 2670. "We installed larger tires, a longer hitch, put guards over steering cables, and installed longer hydraulic control levers. The changes provide better traction and ride, help see when hooking up implements, and make it easier to operate hydraulics. The power of this 2670 is only slightly more than the 2470 but the price is much higher. We installed a Hitachi TV set which has worked perfectly even though it's had water in it twice."

Jack Hoffman, Monticello, Iowa, owns a 1984 International 254. "We're satisfied. It's got a diesel engine, live pto, power steering and a nice compact size. Power's just right for it's size and it's easy on fuel. One thing it could use is a better seat and seat spring, and the over-riding clutch is jerky. I moved the throttle so as not to stumble over it when mounting and dismounting and put better lights on the rear fender. I also added a spring under the seat."

"Wouldn't change a thing on this tractor," says Carl Buhl, Valley, Neb., pleased with his 1985 Deere 4450. "Plenty of power, requires little maintenance and comfort is good."

"We're satisfied but I don't think it will be as dependable as the 4230 it replaced," says Robert Dwire, Arco, Minn... about his 1983 **Deere** 4250. "It has plenty of power but rides rough."

"My dealer made me such a deal I traded all my IH equipment and purchased all new Hesston equipment," says C.E. Ward, Chadwick, Mo., pleased with his 1986 Hesston 780 DT 70 hp. 4-WD made by Fiat. "One thing this tractor needs is a better instruction manual showing breakouts and specs on all parts."

ment for the prices they charge," says Clyde Johnson, Embarrass, Minn., who owns a 190 XT Allis Chalmers. "Very easy handling, good brakes, quick responsive governor, and plenty of power. It doesn't have the best fuel economy and it didn't have steps on the right side. Also the pto is not independent."

"We've had trouble with this 1985
Marshall 802 tractor," says Elmer
Smits, Randolph, Wis. "It had just 27
hrs. on it when the drive gear came
off the camshaft. At 150 hrs. the water
pump went out. The company fixed
both but it took time."
