"COUNTRY TRAPPER'S" REMEDIES GET RESULTS "Home-Brewed" Solutions To Pesky Animal, Insect Problems



Along with many other animals, Bailey has had great success trapping raccoons. He once caught 17 in a single sweet corn patch. He perfects his traps and unusual pest poisons by experimenting with live animals and insects in his shop.

If you've got a problem with bats, rats, mice, skunks, moles, birds, cockroaches, bees or any other pesky critter, you might want to consider calling on the services of "Harold the Friendly Trapper".

Harold Bailey, who lives in rural Ohio, is a master problem solver in the world of pests. Working alone "by the seat of my pants" he's come up with hundreds of "home-brewed" solutions over the years to common farm and household problems involving animal and insect pests.

Here, for example, is his "fool proof" remedy for getting rid of rats and mice: "Put instant mashed potato flakes in a small flat container with a small container of water next to it. Rodents will stuff themselves with flakes. When they drink water, the flakes swell up in their stomachs and they die because mice and rats can't vomit."

Bailey has worked with farmers all over the country. "I've never done any advertising. Word travels that I get results," the former farmer told FARM SHOW. Bailey learned the secrets of the exterminating business entirely through trial and error. He experiments on live animals in his shop. When he finds a product or idea that's particularly effective at controlling an animal
