The Ice Cream Parlor is base drive, with the motor on the bottom. It has a

clear plastic top that lets you watch the process, if you wish. When the frozen dessert is formed, the machine stops automatically and a "ready" light goes on. Comes with a one-year warranty and retails for \$39.99.
