Roll-Off Garbage Containers Haul Forage - New Hampshire farmers Russ Atherton and Tom Morrell have started using big roll-off garbage containers to haul forage in from the field. They park a 50yard container at the side of a field and dump into it with a side dump wagon. A truck then hauls it back to the farm at highway speeds. See page 2.



Front-Mount Cultivator - Iowa farmer Jeff Gravel converted a standard rear-mount cultivator to mount on front of his tractor. Cultivator fastens directly to front of tractor without a 3pt. hitch, which Gravel felt would have put the cultivator out too far in front of tractor. See page 3.

Self-Propelled Rock Picker -Minnesota farmer Wayne Juhl didn't like his commercial rock picker so he built this 3-wheeled, self-propelled rig with a rock picking bucket positioned between the front wheels. It tilts back to dump into a steel hopper which dumps to the side when full. See page 2.
