Revolutionary New Products

FARM SHOW editors travel to all major farm shows in the United States, Canada, and several foreign countries in search of latest new products and ideas. Featured here, and continued on page 2, are three of the best new ideas we've seen lately.

It takes two tractors to pull the new "Double Bladed" field leveler (top). "This revolutionary new tillage tool works the field as aggressively as a field cultivator or disk yet leaves a perfect, level seedbed," says the manufacturer.

A new square bale bagger (right) compresses two 8-ft. long big square bales down to 6 ft., and then shoves them into a sausage-type silage bag, where they re-expand and seal themselves tightly inside.

Everitt Hunley of Austin, Ind., is widely known as one of the best tractor repower experts in North America. Now he's taking on a conversion of a different type with a new tractor "hi-boy" kit (below) that's unlike other high clearance rigs. His system uses direct-drive gearboxes to transmit power to the drive wheels.
