## First-Of-Its-Kind Giant Silage Bagger



You can cover a pile of silage 32 ft. wide and up to 50 ft. long with this giant new silage "bagger" that lets you set up air-tight storage virtually anywhere, eliminating nearly all spoilage. (See story on page 3)

## 20-Ton Tracked Harvester



Giant new 20-ton capacity forage harvester was built by custom harvesters in Kansas. It mounts on four hydrostatically-driven sets of rubber tracks, and articulates in the middle. What makes it unique is the rear-mount hopper that eliminates the need to have a truck or wagon alongside. Silage is blown into rear hopper and then unloaded as needed "on-the-go" without ever stopping cutting. (See story on page 2)

## Home-Built Skid Steer



Rob Martens used parts from two swathers to build this skid-steer loader that's powered by a Wisconsin air-cooled engine. He fitted it with lift arms off a Deere front-end loader. (See story on page 2)
