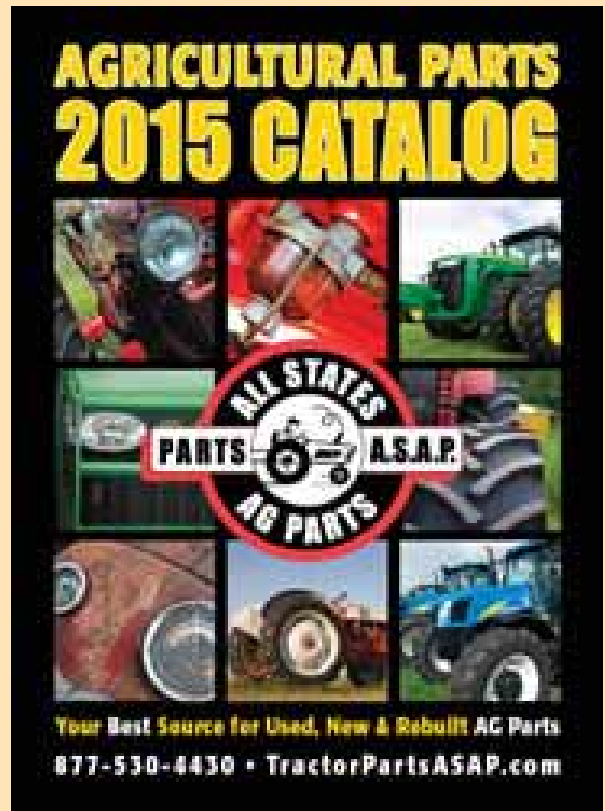
“We do a majority of the rebuilding in our own shops and are extremely confident of the quality of the workmanship and components put into those parts,” Dyke told FARM SHOW.
