Testimonials on the Wartabater website indicate that it has worked for many people who have tried a variety of treatments. It’s safe for children and can also be used on animals. However, it should not be used around the eyes or eyelids or used on people with pacemakers.

“About 10 percent of sales are to people in the medical profession,” Jordan says, noting he is looking at developing a commercial version with replaceable tips as well as one that can be plugged in.

Whatever he does, he plans to keep the business small enough to personally respond to customer’s questions.

“People are initially suspicious of it, and that’s why we enjoy their positive responses so much,” Jordan says.
