New from Finland is a two-handed shovel, designed to make all types of shoveling jobs easier and faster.

"The second stub handle provides a more balanced grip, allowing the operator to increase work output," says the manufacturer of the Pekve shovel. "It can be used in place of an ordinary shovel in almost every task where loose materials are handled.

Makes no difference if the user is left or right handed."

The 20 liter aluminum scoop is available with a high handle, which enables the operator to stand upright, or a low handle for in-bin leveling and shoveling.

Handy "Handle Grip" For Shovels, Forks

Here's a simple way to make the tasks of shoveling, hoeing, raking and handling a fork easier.

Invented by Stan Nelson, New Hope, Minn., the Handle Grip simply clamps onto the lower part of the handle of your shovel, fork, hoe, etc. Once installed, it takes your hand off the handle so you don't get blisters. And, by moving your grasp about 4-in. off the handle, you don't have to bend as far forward and strain your back — yet you get more power and leverage, explains Nelson.

Handle Grip clamps to the lower part of the handle with two bolts. It has a 6-in. wide grip, wide enough for gloved hands.

Sells for \$5.95, plus \$1.25 for shipping.

Grain Truck Shovel

"Works great to clean out grain truck corners," says Art Haugland, Tolna, N. Dak., about his new "Grain Grabber" which eliminates the need to reach over the back endgate to try to reach the bottom of the box.

"Just insert the Grain Grabber through the endgate and clean out both corners. The angle of the shovel and handle is just right so that it will not pull out of the grain when pulling on the handle. Works well in both wet and dry grains."

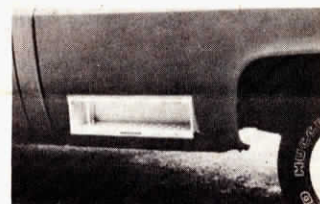

"Side Stepper" For Pickup Trucks

The new "Side Stepper" from Modern Farm, Cody, Wyo., gives you a safe, convenient step for reaching hard-to-get-at fuel tanks, feed bags and other items without getting into the truck bed.

The all-aluminum Side Stepper installs into a hole cut into the side of the truck and has a diamond tread step plate. Measures 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ -in. deep, 5 $\frac{3}{16}$ -in. tall and is available in three widths. Six different finishes are available to complement most trucks.

The 10-in. wide Side Stepper sells for \$46.95; the 16-in. for \$65.95; and the 24-in. wide unit for \$83.95.

FIRST CABS AVAILABLE FOR THESE MODELS

Garden Tractor Cabs

"We're making all-metal cabs for small diesel and gas tractors that have never had cabs available," says Mike Hepola, Deer Creek, Minn., whose compact new cabs come fully equipped with wipers, radios, upholstery, and even air conditioning if the tractor can handle the load.

"Up until now dealers have had to build their own cabs or adapt cabs designed for larger tractors to their machines to satisfy customers. We've built a unit that farmers can install in 1 to 2 hrs. and remove in about 10 minutes in the spring, leaving brackets for quick reinstallation," says Hepola.

Model 900 series cabs are made to fit Allis Chalmers 5015, 5020, 6140, 5220 and 5230 tractors, Deere 318, 430, 750, and 1210; all Simplicity after-market diesels under 40 hp. and 16-25 hp. gas models; and all diesel

Bolens tractors. Model 5015 series cabs fit most Japanese tractors such as Mitsubishi, Kubota, and Iseki.
