"It's the Cadillac of pickups" says Freightliner of its new "pulling pickup" designed for owners of fifth wheel RV's and livestock trailers, and for anyone else interested in owning "the best pickup money can buy".

"We manufacture the Freightliner line of semi cabs and chassis and have designed a way to equip them with a standard box and convert "pulling semis" into "pulling pickups".

"We can equip our custom-designed Freightliner pickup with whatever engine - transmission combination you want. For example, we can install an electronic diesel engine and electronic transmission to get optimum fuel mileage and pulling power. Available options include cruise control, air suspension, air ride cab, air ride high back seats, and a 5th wheel, drawbar or gooseneck hitch.

The custom designed pickup pictured has

an 8,000 lb. front axle, 15,000 lb. rear axle, a 6 speed synchromesh transmission, a Cummins 5.9-liter model 210 diesel engine, and an extended cab. It's also available with a conventional cab and a 4-door model.

"Our new Freightliner is custom designed for the application you have in mind, and the type of performance you're aiming for," the manufacturer points out. "Any option available on a semi-truck, including a sleeping compartment, is available on the Freightliner pickup."

Engine options include the popular new 3126 electronic diesel engine being built exclusively for Freightliner by Caterpillar. It comes standard with cruise control.

Prices start in the high forties (Can.).

New Lawn Rake

Lawn raking is faster, easier and downright fun with the new "no-lift" Powerake.

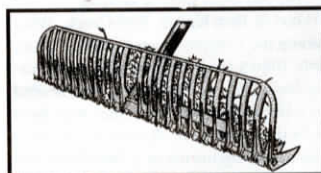
The new-style, multi-purpose garden tool has 25 teeth spaced 1 in. apart. The bottom third of each tooth is angled, causing the tool to rake on the pull stroke and to self-clean on the push stroke.

"This push-pull motion is easier on your back than conventional raking and you can cover more ground. Removes grass clippings, pine needles and leaves without plugging," says the manufacturer.

The rake itself, made of lightweight, high-impact plastic, is 24 in. wide and fitted with a swivel-adjust handle.

You Can Hand Carry This Portable Sawmill

How about this — a portable sawmill so light (only 100 pounds) you can hand carry and load it in your pickup, or on a car-top cargo carrier.

"Our new 'go anywhere' Logosol sawmill saws trunks measuring up to 22 in. in dia., and up to about 16 ft. long, into planks, boards, beams, or laths. Its cutting quality is comparable to that of more expensive framesaws," the manufacturer points out.

With the compact, portable, all-aluminum Logosol, trunks can be sawed on-site into any desired size. With a total length of about 16 ft., it can process trunks of same length.

Unlike stationary sawmills where the trunk is moved through a fixed sawing frame, a conventional chain saw performs the cutting operation on a stationary trunk. The saw rests on a sledge which is moved along the trunk by hand-crank cable winch.

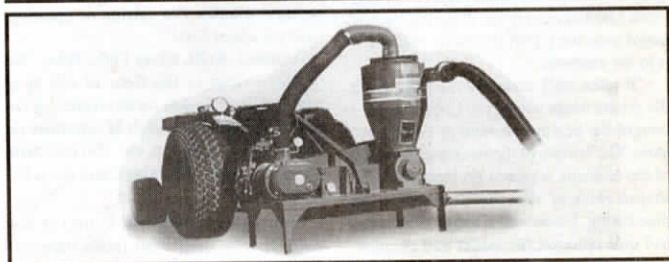
Short trunks can be sawed as easily as trunks up to about 16 ft. in length. If longer trunks are being processed, the Logosol's all-aluminum frame can be extended an extra 6.5 ft. or so.

Cutting speed, on a 6 in. dia. trunk, is right at 5 ft. per minute. Boards and slats can be precision cut to a thickness of about 1/4 in.

Most makes of chainsaws with an 18 in. blade and a 92cc engine, can be used on the Logosol. However, the manufacturer recommends the Stihl 064 with a picco chain sprocket, the Stihl 066 or the Stihl 084.

Retails for right at \$3,425 (Can.) with a Stihl chain saw, and \$2,395 without.

New "Uni-Swivel" Hydraulic Auger

"Farmers who've seen it tell us it's the best unloading auger on the market," says J and M Manufacturing of its new "Uni-Swivel".

A patented (pending) pulley and track stabilizer design allows the auger to move to any working position and yet maintain a downwardly positioned discharge spout. The auger stays in any position without pulling to center.

Variable winch-operated unloading height allows you to raise the auger and unload into a storage bin, or to lower the auger to bag up the last few bushels.

A "one size fits all" adjustable hopper adapts to almost any size gravity box with side discharge and sliding door.

The auger is positioned above the grain line, eliminating spattering of grain or fertilizer. A "sump designed" intake allows



continuous flow and excellent clean-out.

A 13 ft. long unloader with a 6 in. dia. steel auger, stabilizer bar, cable winch assembly, downspout, adjustable hopper and hydraulic motor valve and hoses, sells for \$965; a 15 ft. long unloader sells for \$990. Loaders equipped with brush augers sell for \$1,245 (13 ft. long) and \$1,320 (15 ft. long).

New Grain Vac Fits Your Farm

Regardless of how big or small your farming operation, the new 310 Agri-Vac grain mover from Walinga is "tailor made" for you.

Moving up to 600 bu. per hour and weighing less than 1,000 lbs., it "fits" larger farms as a first-of-its kind grain mover that can get into the tightest corners to clean out bins and pits, to salvage spills, and to perform transfer and loading operations.

For smaller farms, the new 310 offers respectable capacity at an "affordable" price — right at \$5,500 for the pto-model.

Hook it on the 3-pt. hitch of a 20 to 30 hp tractor and the pto-operated 310 can be

taken anywhere the tractor will go. It comes with a stand that allows it to rest on the ground during operation.

The 310 is also available with an electric motor (10 to 20 hp) drive. This "electric" model is mounted on a 3-wheeled cart for easy maneuvering into storage corners.

You can also buy the new 310 with a 25 hp. gas engine drive.
