



Scented Light Bulb

Turning on this new light bulb releases sweet-smelling fragrances.

The Sylvania Lite Scents lamp comes packaged with tablets that give off the scent of cranberry, orange blossom, or pine and are designed to last the 1,000-hour average rated life of the 25-watt bulb.

The scented tablet is placed in an indentation on top of the bulb. When the lamp is

turned on, bulb heat vaporizes the solid tablet, releasing the fragrance into the room. "It's an alternative to scented candles or incense, eliminating the danger of an open flame," says the manufacturer.

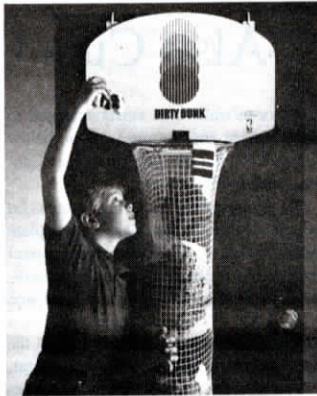

Two-Flavor Ice Cream Maker

You can make 2 pints of different flavor ice cream at the same time using the "Duet" ice cream maker.

The new ice cream maker has a dual cavity freezing chamber which is frozen and then removed, while still empty, from the freezer. The ingredients are placed inside and they're put back in the machine where paddles churn as the ice cream freezes. In about 25 min. 1 pint of each flavor is ready.

"The Duet is fun and easy to use because you can use a basic vanilla base for each flavor and merely add extra ingredients such as chocolate chips or crushed fruit to vary the flavor of each pint," says president Galelio Buzzi-Ferraris.

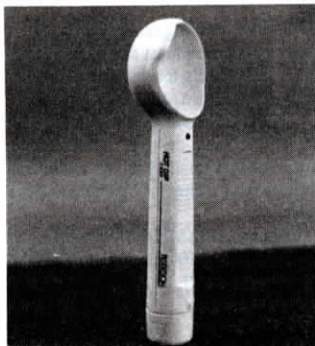
Heated Gourmet Ice Cream Scoop

New Vehicle Light Always Ready To Use

The charging system on your car, truck or tractor keeps this new flashlight fully charged and ready to perform at all times.

"When you need a flashlight, they always seem to have weak batteries. With this new light, you just wire the charging base into the 6, 12 or 24 volt system on your vehicle or equipment and forget about it," says Barry Englot, manufacturer.

Once charged the high-power light provides up to 3 hrs. of continuous service before needing recharging. Can be recharged up to 2,000 times. You can mount the charging base anywhere that's out of the way. A magnetic clip holds the light securely so you can keep your hands free while working. An indicator light tells you when the light is charging. Once charged, it'll hold the charge for up to a year if you keep it out of the base.

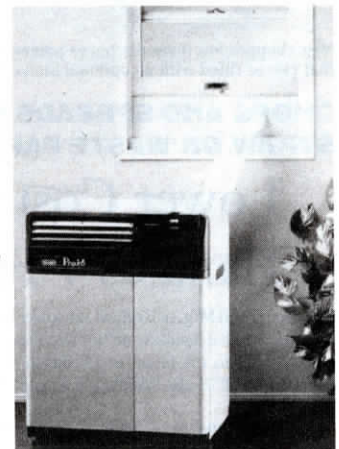
"Windowless" Air Conditioner

First-of-its-kind "windowless" air conditioner is mounted on 4 wheels, allowing it to be easily moved from room to room.

Unlike conventional window air conditioners that use hot summer air to cool down condenser coils, the Pinguino unit is water-cooled and operates entirely within a room, making the system completely portable. It can cool the living room during the day, then be moved to the bedroom for the evening. Its compact design also makes for easy transportation by car for use in summer homes.

A 3.7 gal. refillable water tank keeps the primary condenser cooled for about 8 hours. When the water supply runs out, the unit automatically switches to a secondary air-cooled condenser (similar to that found in standard "window" air conditioners) that uses fan-forced air to cool the system. This dual-condenser allows Pinguino to operate at maximum output during the hottest part of the day (water-cooled operation) and at 65% output during evening hours (air-cooled operation). It also dehumidifies as it cools.

Humidity and heat generated within the machine are exhausted from the house through a plastic tube connected to a window.
